

- · A notarized copy of the employment record book or its equivalent (if applicable)
- · A notarized copy of identity card or passport
- · Diploma with transcripts
- · Resumé/CV
- · 3 Essays (Essay questions are given in the application form for Master's Degree)
- · Preliminary research proposal (2,000 words) for PhD Degree

- · Motivation letter for PhD Degree
- · 2 confidential reference letters
- · English Language Proficiency results

Note: Candidates with Bachelor/Master's degree (or equivalent) from educational institutions where English is the primary language of instruction are exempt from submission of TOEFL or IELTS scores.

- · 6.5 on the IELTS test (with not less than 6.0 in individual elements), or its TOEFL equivalent.
- · GRE results (optional)

Please note that meeting the minimum requirements do not imply automatic admission into the program.
